### **New Pioneer club classes will begin Jan 18 - Feb 15**

Trailblazers (5th&6th graders) Woodworking/Meeting Jesus

Examine scriptural witnesses to Jesus' deity and draw conclusions from this evidence.

Understand that because Jesus was a human being as well as God he can understand all our feelings, needs, and temptations. Understand God's plan for salvation. Realize what Jesus' lordship is and take steps to show that Jesus is in charge of their life.

In this unit children will make a bird house while learning how to safely use saws, drills and hammers.

Pathfinders ( 3rd & 4th graders) Carpentry/Home and Heart

Recognize respectful ways to respond to parents and understand why God disciplines us and how he wants parents to discipline children. Recognize that Jesus chose to obey God, and why it is important to obey our parents. Learn ways to be a peacemaker and be willing to practice it at home. The Pathfinders will also learn some beginning carpentry skills and how to safely handle woodworking tools.

Voyagers (1st & 2nd graders) Tools/Doing What's Right

The Voyagers will understand why God wants us to avoid lying and stealing and desire to always be truthful. They will understand how important it means to follow Jesus. They will learn ways God wants them to respond when someone is unkind and to resist peer pressure.

Participants will learn how to use basic tools and use them safely. They will learn how to saw a board & drill a hole. They will hammer a nail & pull it out again, and tighten a screw.
